Membership

- The U.S. Transhumanist Party became open for membership when Gennady Stolyarov II became Chairman on November 17, 2016.
- Membership is free and always will be.
- Non-US residents can be Allied Members and vote on our internal ballots.



- 700 members thus far.
- Goal is to reach 10,000 members within another year.

Transhumanist Bill of Rights, v2.0

- Version 1.0 written by Zoltan Istvan, delivered to the U.S. Capitol on December 14, 2015. 6 Articles in total.
- Version 2.0 adopted by ranked-preference voting of U.S. Transhumanist
 Party members on December 25-31, 2016. 25 Articles and an extensive
 Preamble broadly defining the sentient entities to whom rights should
 apply.



- Focus on life extension, health, morphological freedom, technological progress, privacy, self-improvement

- 63 planks, based on member recommendations, adopted over five voting periods of the members during January-June, 2017.
- Each voting period is preceded by an exposure period of 15+ days to allow members and the public to comment and suggest wording options.
- New exposure period runs through November 11, 2017 when Platform Vote #6 will begin: 19 proposed new planks, 3 proposed amendments to existing planks. See the options at

- Electronic ranked-preference voting.

Foreign Ambassador Program

- Aim to expand the international reach of transhumanist ideas and collaboration among transhumanists of all countries.
- Role of a Foreign Ambassador:
 - Recruit Allied Members
 - Provide periodic reports of activities (e.g., special events held, methods of communication, achievements)
 - Write status-update articles for publication on U.S. Transhumanist Party website
- Thus far, we have Foreign Ambassadors in Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, Egypt, England, Hong Kong, India, Nigeria, and Scotland.
