

#### **Round 1: Tally of First Choices**

**Johannon Ben Zion:** 109 votes – 34.94% **Rachel Haywire:** 72 votes - 23.08%Kristan T. Harris: 35 votes - 11.22%**Charles Holsopple:** 30 votes - 9.62%John J. Kerecz: 19 votes - 6.09%**Matt Taylor:** 17 votes - 5.45%None of the Above: 13 votes - 4.17%Vrillon: 9 votes -2.88%Jonathan Schattke: 8 votes - 2.56%

In Round 1, no candidate receives a clear majority. **Jonathan Schattke is removed**, and his votes are re-assigned to the #2 preferences of the voters who favored him. All voter preferences ranked below Jonathan Schattke are shifted up by one ranking.

#### **Round 2: Tally of First Choices after Reassignment**

Johannon Ben Zion: 111 votes - 35.58%Rachel Haywire: 76 votes - 24.36%Kristan T. Harris: 36 votes - 11.54%Charles Holsopple: 30 votes - 9.62%John J. Kerecz: 19 votes - 6.09%Matt Taylor: 18 votes - 5.77%None of the Above: 13 votes - 4.17%Vrillon: 9 votes - 2.88%

In Round 2, no candidate receives a clear majority. **Vrillon is removed**, and his votes are re-assigned to the #2 preferences of the voters who favored him. All voter preferences ranked below Vrillon are shifted up by one ranking.

#### **Round 3: Tally of First Choices after Reassignment**

Johannon Ben Zion:114 votes - 36.54%Rachel Haywire:78 votes - 25.00%Kristan T. Harris:36 votes - 11.54%Charles Holsopple:30 votes - 9.62%Matt Taylor:21 votes - 6.73%John J. Kerecz:19 votes - 6.09%None of the Above:14 votes - 4.49%

In Round 3, no candidate receives a clear majority. **The "None of the Above" option is removed**, and its votes are re-assigned to the #2 preferences of the voters who favored it. All voter preferences ranked below "None of the Above" are shifted up by one ranking.

#### **Round 4: Tally of First Choices after Reassignment**

Johannon Ben Zion:117 votes - 37.50%Rachel Haywire:81 votes - 25.96%Kristan T. Harris:39 votes - 12.50%Charles Holsopple:32 votes - 10.26%John J. Kerecz:22 votes - 7.05%Matt Taylor:21 votes - 6.73%

In Round 4, no candidate receives a clear majority. **Matt Taylor is removed**, and his votes are reassigned to the #2 preferences of the voters who favored him. All voter preferences ranked below Matt Taylor are shifted up by one ranking.

#### **Round 5: Tally of First Choices after Reassignment**

Johannon Ben Zion: 124 votes – 39.74%

Rachel Haywire: 83 votes – 26.60%

Kristan T. Harris: 42 votes – 13.46%

Charles Holsopple: 36 votes – 11.54%

John J. Kerecz: 27 votes – 8.65%

In Round 5, no candidate receives a clear majority. **John J. Kerecz is removed**, and his votes are reassigned to the #2 preferences of the voters who favored him. All voter preferences ranked below John J. Kerecz are shifted up by one ranking.

#### Round 6: Tally of First Choices after Reassignment

**Johannon Ben Zion:** 137 votes - 43.91% **Rachel Haywire:** 86 votes - 27.56% **Charles Holsopple:** 46 votes - 14.74%**Kristan T. Harris:** 43 votes - 13.78%

In Round 6, no candidate receives a clear majority. **Kristan T. Harris is removed**, and his votes are re-assigned to the #2 preferences of the voters who favored him. All voter preferences ranked below Kristan T. Harris are shifted up by one ranking.

#### Round 7: Tally of First Choices after Reassignment

**Johannon Ben Zion:** 160 votes – 51.28% **Rachel Haywire:** 97 votes – 31.09% **Charles Holsopple:** 55 votes – 17.63%

**Johannon Ben Zion** secures a majority of votes in Round 7 and therefore wins the election.

Accordingly, Johannon Ben Zion receives the U.S. Transhumanist Party's endorsement as candidate for President of the United States in 2020.

# **Validation by Software: Instant-Runoff Voting Tool**

The open-source Instant-Runoff Voting Tool, developed by Peter Grassberger and available at <a href="https://petertheone.github.io/IRV/">https://petertheone.github.io/IRV/</a>, was used to validate instant-runoff calculations and ensure that there were no errors in the Excel tabulation process. The linked <a href="text-file">text file</a> contains the inputs entered into the Instant-Runoff Voting Tool to produce the output below.
